A	<p>Outdoor/Indoor Training Dates:</p> <p style="margin-left: 20px;">a. Outdoor Training</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">i. Main pitch closed – due to reopen after March 17TH.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">ii. Community Centre - Indoor training to continue to April (date to be decided). Training to transfer to main pitch after Easter break (dates TBC)</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">iii. Hockey Pitch – Fe9's & Fe10's return to training on Wednesdays 6pm-7pm (date TBC). Fe11's training Tuesday 6pm-7pm.</p>
B	<p><u>Upcoming Courses:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Foundation Level Training - Next course will be run early 2018 to accommodate new coaches with new Fe6 group (15 coaches outstanding for this course). Confirmation required whether GAA Foundation course is 'recommended' by GAA or 'mandatory'. - Child Welfare Training - New Child Protection course to be run in early 2018 (to be confirmed). Note that latest legislation requires that all adults 'assisting' with teams must have appropriate training completed, i.e. Garda Vetting & Child Protection. This includes coaches and parents assisting on infrequent occasions. - Gold Award – congratulations to all involved for recent awarding of the Gold Award from Rebel Og - Coaching Courses: decision required as to which GDA course will be provided and dates for same. Club to see if CBS pitch is available for these courses. - Suicide Awareness: date for course to be confirmed by Ingrid.

C	<p>First Aid:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Thanks to Ber Cotter for the Health & Safety course provided before Christmas. - All managers to update team first aid bags if required in Murphy's Pharmacy, Midleton. - DEFIBILOTAR Access Code: 0000 ✓(NB ✓ needs to be after 0000).
D	<p>Player Registration/ Membership:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Proposed registration date for all clubs is now Saturday February 17th .(Adult/ Juvenile/ Camogie/ Ladies Football). Tracy still waiting for clarification from Croke Park regarding a template for combined application form. Review of logistic of registration day to be decided (payment/ forms/ PR etc). - Membership rates TBC - Tracy to upload details of any players transferring to club ASAP. Note that any player transferring to new club must wait 48 weeks from date of last match with outgoing club (if not living in the parish of new club). Transferring player must sign transfer form.
E	<p>GAA Injury Benefit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club awaiting confirmation regarding cover period – latest advice is that all players need to be registered on or before January 01st each year in order to be covered by GAA Injury Benefit scheme. Membership can be paid before March 31st. Tracy to re-register all players listed from 2017 ASAP.
