	3. Further to investigations within Midleton GAA Club regarding the recent incident		
	at Fé16 match between individual coaching staff of both Midleton & Kiltha Óg,		
	Midleton GAA Club has imposed a suspension of 2 league matches or 1 month		
	(whichever happens first) on Steve Kane, Fe16 manager. Midleton Juvenile		
	Secretary will email Kiltha Og requesting details of Kiltha Og's involvement in this		
	incident and any subsequent disciplinary action to be taken.		
	4. Note to all managers (Fe13-Fe16 incl) – Midleton GAA Club policy now is where		
	the referee does not turn up for a scheduled league match then the match should not be played. Please make opposition aware of this new club policy.		
	5. Fe13 looking at possible trip to Dublin to play a Dublin team on Sunday 29 th July. Ray Fitzgerald to establish the cost of the bus and look to cover the majority of
